How do I participate in the lottery?

Ask yourself: Do I have a project that is already facilitated? Do I promise to turn in a new episode for this project *at least* every four weeks in order to qualify as a series? If your answer to both of these questions is *yes*, then you can participate in the lottery.

The procedure for participating in the lottery is simple:

- 1 Consult the enclosed lottery rules and channel schedule grid guides for channels 72/120 (Comcast analog/Cox digital), 73/98 (Comcast/Cox analog) and 74/99 (Comcast/Cox analog) to determine where best to place your series.
- 2 Fill out the Lottery Application Form, listing your first, second and third choice for your series' cablecast time and day. When your series is selected at random during the lottery you will receive your first choice if it is available. If that time and day has already been selected by another producer, you will receive your second choice (and so on).
- 3 Please return the completed and signed application form to Access Tucson by the deadline of **Wednesday, January 30th before 9PM**. Unsigned applications will not be accepted. All applications mailed in, faxed in or dropped off at the front desk will be logged in by a Member Service Representative to verify receipt of your application.

How do I schedule additional series?

Again, members may enter only ONE series into the lottery so any additional series can be scheduled after the lottery beginning on Thursday February 14, 2008 using a regular cablecast appointment.

Cablecast Lottery Rules

- 1 Members may enter only ONE series into the lottery.
- 2 ALL PROJECTS ENTERED INTO THE LOTTERY MUST HAVE ALREADY BEEN FACILITATED.
- 3 All live shows in both Studio A & B must alternate every other week.
- 4 If a live producer chooses a live slot on the digital channel (72 Comcast analog/120 Cox digital), then they will be able to choose a replay time instantly on an analog channel during the live round of the lottery.
- 5 Members may schedule a second weekly cablecast time (replay) for only one series. If your first play is on an analog channel, your second play must be on the digital channel and vice versa.
- 6 Only one cablecast time slot per series can be scheduled between 6 to 10 PM ("primetime").
- 7 Members may sponsor only one active imported series, up to 1:58:30 in length.
- 8 Any member may replay an old/completed series. However, a replay of an old/completed series (local or import) can only be done for one season only after its initial run.
- 9 On a first come, first serve basis, each member can cablecast up to four hours of programming total per week.
- 10 Series containing adult content must be scheduled between the hours of midnight and 6 AM.
